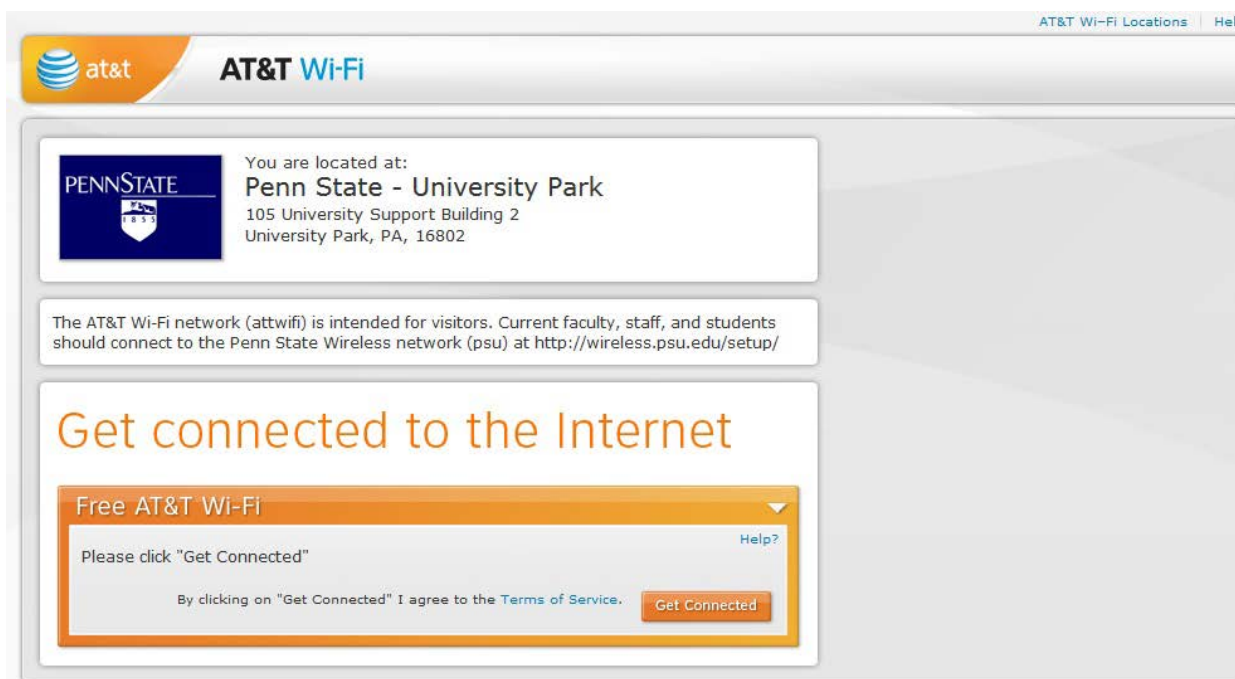


## AT&T Visitors Wireless – Smeal College of Business building

To facilitate network access in our building, as a visitor to our campus, you may access our AT&T wifi visitor wireless service from your personal computer in our Business Building.

### To get started using Visitor Wireless:

- Check your wireless network signal for the Visitor Wireless network named **attwifi**
- Connect to attwifi by configuring your wireless network settings to access attwifi.
- Open your Web browser to automatically launch the AT&T Wi-Fi web screen.
